

Presentations

In addition to the plenary sessions on the colloquium's topics, you will have the opportunity to attend smaller disciplinary sections on 3 November to discuss specific topics within your scientific field.

As already announced in the invitation, we will give you the opportunity for you to present your actual research activities in short talks during the Networking Session with Early Career Researchers and/or present a poster in the subsequent poster session in the afternoon of 3 November. Official language will be English. Each presentation needs to reference the topic on the specific section and should include the focus on your personal scientific research.

Short Talk

Please consider the following general guidelines:

- To be considered for a presentation, you need to submit an abstract and a title (see "Conference Volume").
- You are free to participate in any section, however, short talks can only be considered if relating to the topic of the specific section.

Please consider the following general guidelines for your short talk:

- Approx. 5 presentations per section will be considered.
- Your presentation should be prepared for a maximum of 15 minutes. After each talk, there will be time for questions and discussion.
- Your presentation should be held in English and commonly understandable. Please keep the interdisciplinary audience of the meeting in mind when preparing your presentation and provide a general introduction to your project in the context of your field. Most fellows are not active in your field of research.
- You will be informed in due time whether your short talk has been selected. The selection of presentations will seek to achieve a well-balanced composition of the different disciplines and a strict reference to the topic of the session; the talks are not judged by their scientific quality.



Poster

Please consider the following guidelines for your poster:

- The design of your poster is entirely up to you.
- You will have a space allocated of 90 cm width x 130 cm height.
- Please bring your printed poster to the meeting.
- The poster session will take place in the conference hotel. Please hang up your poster during the 3 November until 14:00 h.
- Poster boards and pins will be available.
