

Presentations

In addition to the plenary sessions on the Colloquium’s thematic issues, you will have the opportunity to attend interdisciplinary workshops on 12 April to discuss specific topics within your academic field.

We would like to give you the opportunity to present your current research in short presentations and/or to present a poster in the subsequent poster session. Official languages will be English and German.

These presentations should remain within the broader scope of the respective academic field with a focus on your specific research topic.

The aim of the interdisciplinary workshops is to highlight current research by Humboldt alumni and participating early career researchers in five loosely defined interdisciplinary areas:

- 1 Languages, Literature, History
- 2 Law, Economics, Social Sciences
- 3 Health, Life Sciences, Geosciences
- 4 Chemistry, Materials Engineering
- 5 Physics, Mathematics, Computer Science, Engineering Science

Within the setting of the conference, the workshops also aim to

- provide a platform for discussion of trends in current research and research cooperation between Spain, Portugal, France, Belgium, Netherlands, Luxembourg and Germany
- allow colleagues in neighbouring fields to get to know each other and discuss possible research collaborations
- allow for an exchange about the conference topic between Humboldt alumni, early career researchers, members of the German delegation, and Humboldt Foundation staff in smaller groups.

The workshops will be attended by Humboldt alumni, early career researchers and guests. They will be chaired by members of the German delegation and Humboldt alumni. Humboldt Foundation staff will be available for questions and support.

Information on Short Presentations in Workshops

Please consider the following general guidelines:

- To be considered for a short presentation of your current research, please submit an **abstract** and a **title** via the abstract submission form: <https://session.conventus.de/index.php?id=603&L=1>.
- While you are free to participate in any section, short presentations can only be considered if they relate to the topic of the specific section.
- We ask for your understanding that due to constraints of time only a small number of presentations per section can be considered.
- Your presentation should be prepared for a **maximum (!) of 10 minutes**. After each talk, there will be time for questions and discussion.
- Your presentation should be held in English or German and be accessible to a wider audience. Please keep the interdisciplinary audience of the meeting in mind when preparing your presentation and provide a general introduction to your project in the context of your field. Give the audience a general idea of your current research and omit information that is comprehensible only to experts in the narrow field.
- Include information on your research as a Humboldtian and collaborations with German partners in your talk, speak briefly about your experience as a Humboldtian in Germany.
- You will be informed in due course whether your short talk has been selected. The selection of presentations will seek to achieve a well-balanced composition of the different disciplines and a strict reference to the thematic scope of the session.

Information on Poster Presentations during the Poster Session

Please consider the following guidelines for your poster:

- The design of your poster is entirely up to you.
- You will have a space allocated of 90 cm width x 130 cm height. The posters should fit to the maximum size of DIN A0 portrait.
- Please bring your printed poster to the meeting.
- The poster session will take place at the Hotel Meliá Avenida América Please put up your poster on 12 April during lunch break.
- Poster boards and pins will be made available.
- There is no limited number for posters; all registered posters will be accepted for presentation.
