

Presentations

In addition to the plenary sessions on the colloquium's topics, you will have the opportunity to attend smaller disciplinary sections on 18 October to discuss specific topics within your academic field.

As already announced in the invitation, we will give you the opportunity to present your current research activities in short talks and/or to present a poster in the subsequent poster session. Official languages will be German and English. Each presentation needs to reference the topic of the specific section and should bring your own research into focus.

Short Talk

Please consider the following general guidelines:

- To be considered for a host talk, please submit an **abstract** and a **title**
- You are free to participate in any section; however, short talks can only be considered if relating to the topic of the specific section.
- Only few presentations per section can be considered.
- Your presentation should be prepared for a maximum of 15 minutes. After each talk, there will be time for questions and discussion.
- Your presentation should be held in English or German and commonly understandable. Please keep the interdisciplinary audience of the meeting in mind when preparing your presentation and provide a general introduction to your project in the context of your field. Most fellows are not active in your field of research.
- You will be informed in due time whether your short talk has been selected. The selection of presentations will seek to achieve a well-balanced composition of the different disciplines and a strict reference to the topic of the session; the talks are not judged by their academic quality.

Poster

Please consider the following guidelines for your poster:

- The design of your poster is entirely up to you.
- You will have a space allocated of 90 cm width x 130 cm height. The posters should fit to the maximum size of DIN A0 portrait (84,1 cm x 118,9 cm).
- Please bring your printed poster to the meeting.
- The poster session will take place in the conference hotel. Please put up your poster on 18 October until 14:00 h.
- Poster boards and pins will be available.
- There is no limited number for posters; all posters will be accepted for presentation.
